


LOSSAN Rail Corridor Overview

351-mile rail corridor through six counties

- 7 Right-of-Way Owners (55% freight owned)
- 29 Pacific Surfliner Stations

Hosts busiest statesupported Amtrak route in United States – Pacific Surfliner


LOSSAN Rail Corridor Ridership and Service Overview

- 5 roundtrips extend north of Los Angeles to Goleta
- 2 roundtrips extend to San Luis Obispo






FFY24 Boardings and Alightings YTD



LOSSAN Rail Corridor Station Boardings & Alightings



Delays by Responsible Party




Top 5 Delays Types

Pacific Surfliner Trespasser / Vehicle Strikes


- Strikes are typically higher during the winter holidays
- In FFY24, 68% of strikes have been trespassers / 32% are vehicular.
- In FFY24, 95% of fatal strikes have been trespasser strikes
- 86% of trespasser strikes have not been at a crossing.

Annual Business Plan




- The Los-Angeles-San Diego-San Luis Obispo (LOSSAN) Rail Corridor Agency (Agency) is required to submit an Annual Business Plan (ABP) to the CalSTA Secretary by April 1st of each year.
- The ABP is a two-year planning, operations, and budget document that serves as the LOSSAN Agency's formal operations, maintenance, and management plan and funding request to CalSTA.
- The interagency transfer agreement prescribes the elements of the ABP and includes:
 - A report on performance of the Pacific service;
 - An overall operating plan, including proposed service enhancements;
 - A marketing plan;
 - A short- and long-term capital improvement program;
 - The funding requirements for the upcoming fiscal year.

Annual Business Plan Development Process The development and submittal of the ABP is a six-month process that incorporates input from the LOSSAN Technical Advisory Committee (TAC) and Board.
