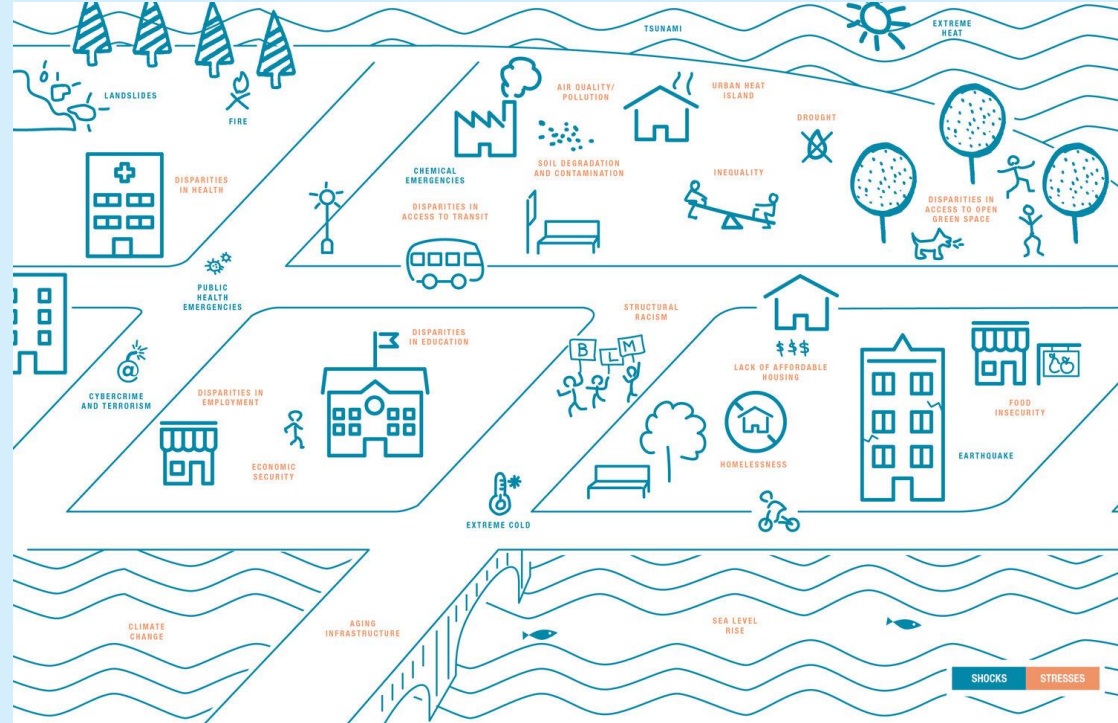

Benefits of a Regional Approach

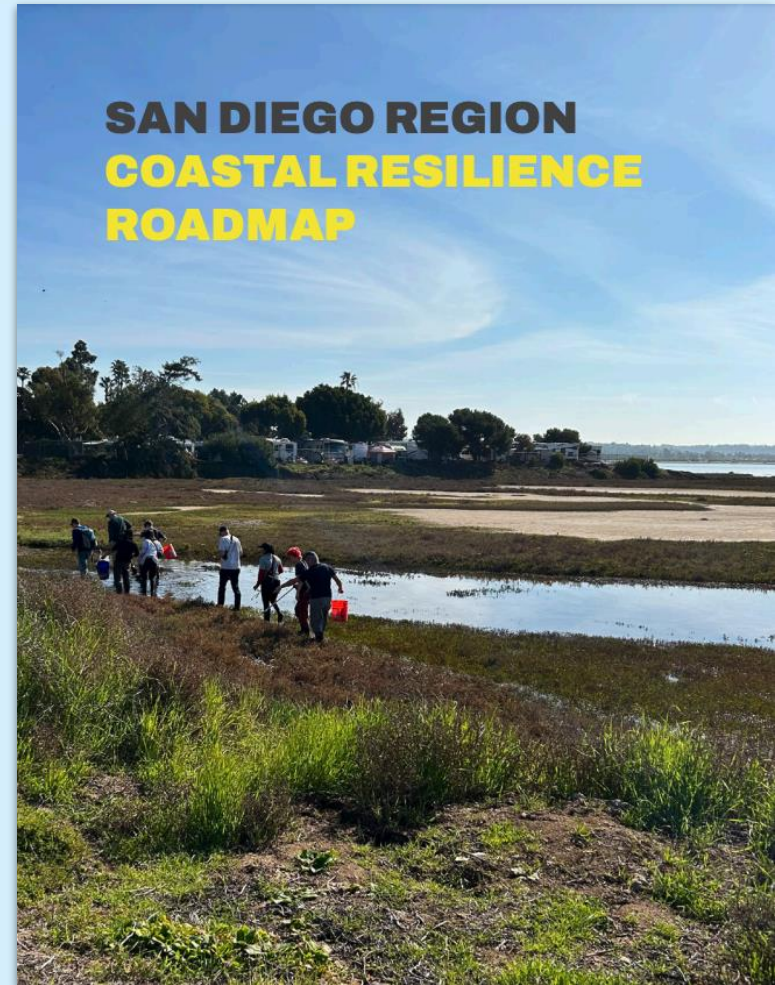
- Impacts of **shocks** and **stresses** extend beyond political / jurisdictional boundaries: addressing these integrated risks requires a **regional scale** effort

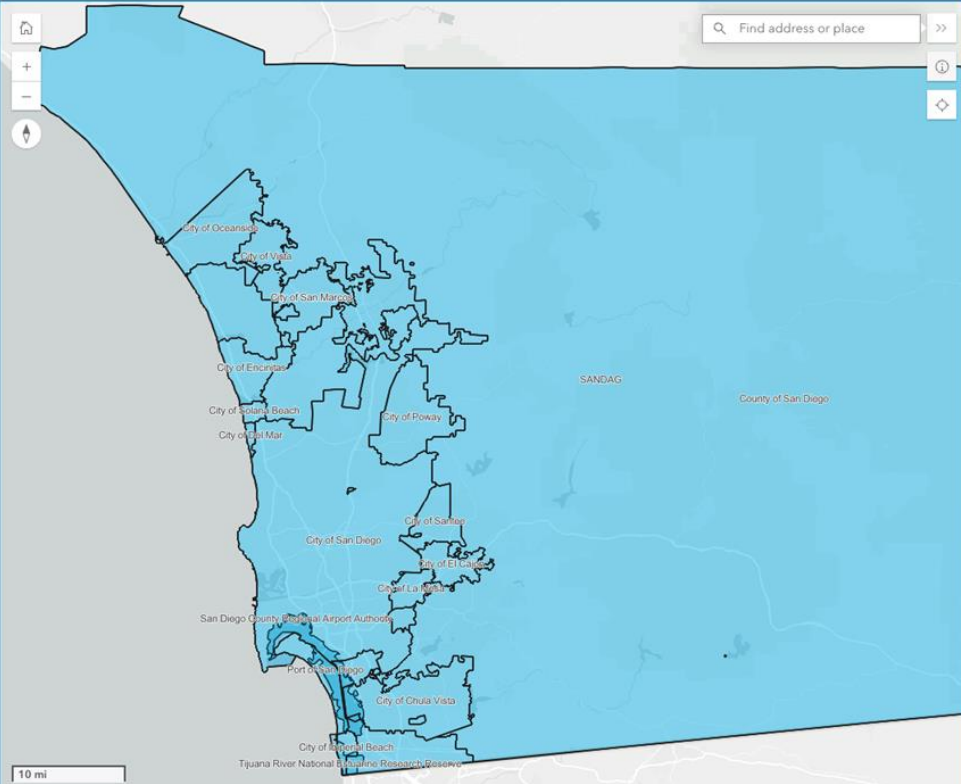
