

METROLINK





Metrolink operates on seven routes across a six-county, 538 routemiles network.

Commuter rail provides the same capacity as two lanes of parallel freeway traffic. Commuter rail is part of a regional solution to ease congestion on all major freeways and connect residents to opportunities.

Metrolink trains travel at speeds up-to 79 mph, with higher speeds possible with track and operating improvements.

Book-end and connectivity investments are critical to a successful high-speed rail system.

Link Union Station and the Rosecrans / Marquardt Grade Separation Projects are critical for the region.

There are projects in the Metrolink service area with independent utility that improve rail service across Southern California. The Southern California Optimized Rail Expansion (SCORE) can deliver success in the region.

The SCORE program will increase rail service, reduce freeway traffic and improve air quality.
